How to apply to join?

Four steps:

1. The application form can be found on ACMC's website (<https://acmc.asia/Registrations>). Kindly fill the form out as directed and submit it for.
2. Candidates are requested to link two audition videos in the registration form for the admissions committee's review. You will be notified of our decision once your application has been reviewed.
3. Please allow us 2-6 months to review your application. You will be notified of our decision through email. Additional resources might be requested from you to help us in our admissions process.
4. You are required to make your payment AFTER you are accepted. We will make known our decision about your request for financial aid once you are accepted. (if applicable)

Send flight details:

- Please send in your flight details once they are booked so that transportation can be arranged. (If applicable)

How to take opportunity of the referral discounts:

- Each participant has the opportunity to get a \$5 discount if the participant successfully refers another candidate. There is no limit as to how many people you can refer. Referral works by listing the names that you have referred to in the application form, the referral discount will be applied to you once the person you referred is admitted.

Cancellation

Once application is accepted, ACMC expects applicants to be present. If a cancellation is necessary, please notify us immediately.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter. A half refund will be given provided cancellation is made prior to camp. A refund of camp fees cannot be made a month before the camp begins.

Refund policy

We have a partial refund, transferable policy. This means that we provide a 50% refund up to 2 months before the conference. However, you are welcomed to transfer your seat to another person without extra charge, provided that the request to do so is submitted and the person passes the audition.

Camp organization

Language

All sessions, and talks will be held in english. There will be no translations.
All participants need to have a basic understanding of the english language.

Lodging

Lodging at Aenon will only be provided for paid participants. Lodging for visitors, friends, parents, family members, guardian, and/or chaperone who are not part of the conference will not be provided. If in any case a guardian/chaperone is required, lodging outside of Aenon can be arranged and the guardian/chaperone will have to pay a separate fee for meals and presentations.

For both air conditioned and non air conditioned rooms it will be a four people shared bedroom. If you require to stay by yourself, or in a double room with a friend you would be required to write in a special request, and would be charged an extra fee.

Non-Participants accompanying a friend or family member will have the choice to join the conference at a different price and room. More updates will be coming shortly.

Please note: Non air conditioned rooms will be in dormitory style.

Worthy participant fund attendees will not have a choice of room.

Problems at Camp

It is normal that conflicts develop where there are people - interpersonal conflicts, discontentment with certain situations, discouragement, and so on. However, conflicts should be perceived as an opportunity to grow and build character, and it should not undermine the focus and unity of the camp. The appropriate and recommended steps in resolving any conflicts that arise during camp would be to seek the Lord for guidance in prayer, and then first approaching the person whom you have had a conflict with. If this doesn't resolve the conflict, camp counsellors or staff members can always be sought out for advice and help in dealing with the situation. Much harm can be done by speaking with other participants, staff members, or even parents concerning conflicts faced; therefore it is always recommended that one first seeks to go to "your brother, and first tell him his fault between you and him alone."
